Rules and Requirements

For 37 years the Bangor Symphony Orchestra has been encouraging and recognizing the outstanding talents of Maine's high school instrumentalists. We invite you to become a part of this long history by participating in the 37th Annual Maine High School Concerto Competition.

The first-prize winner for the Annas-Cupp Award will be featured in a concerto performance with the Bangor Symphony Orchestra at the annual Young People's Concerts. Don't miss this opportunity to showcase your talents and become part of Bangor Symphony Orchestra history!

Eligibility: This competition is open to any string, woodwind, brass, percussion, harp, and piano students in grades 9 through 12, at the time of the application due date. Entrants must not have graduated and must be enrolled in high school or high school program (e.g. home school). Entrants must not have taken the GED. Dual enrollment students are eligible. Entrants must be Maine residents, but may attend high school outside the state of Maine. If questions arise, proof of age, enrollment, and residency may be necessary. Winners of the Annas-Cupp Award in any preceding year are ineligible to compete.

All applicants must submit the following:

- 1) Participants are required to submit video/audio recording materials. You may upload a file, mail in a CD or provide a YouTube (or other music sharing website) link of the student performing one movement of a concerto in the standard orchestral repertoire. The selected movement can be up to 12 minutes in length, uncut*. All recordings must include the accompaniment. No pre-recorded accompaniments, please. If a traditional recording is not possible, you may also record with a high quality cellphone. Listen to your recording before you send it in, quality is important. Private teachers should not accompany their students for the recording submission or live recital.
- 2) Copy of the music with each measure numbered
- 3) Completed application form

Note: There is no entrance fee

All applications must be postmarked prior to midnight, January 12, 2018

*Any exceptions to the length rule and approval for any cuts or transcriptions must be requested in writing and approved by the Competition committee prior to video/audio submission

Competition Procedures: Recordings will be evaluated by a committee of Bangor Symphony Orchestra musicians. By February 9, 2018, finalists will be chosen to participate in a public audition recital at Minsky Hall on the University of Maine, Orono campus.

Contestants must provide their own accompanist. On the day of the finals, students and their accompanists may rehearse in the performing hall during the morning. The final audition, in the form of a public recital, will take place that afternoon. If needed, we can help facilitate the search for an accompanist.

Awards:

First Place Annas-Cupp Award \$500 and will be featured in a concerto performance with the Bangor

Symphony Orchestra during their annual Young People's Concerts

Second Place Friends Award \$250 Third Place Friends Award \$150

The number of finalist awards may be limited at the discretion of the Competition Committee. Any exceptions to the above rules will only be considered if a special request in writing is made to the Competition Committee prior to the application. Address inquiries to:
